EUROPEAN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME IN EPIDEMIOLOGY

11th RESIDENTIAL SUMMER COURSE FLORENCE 22 JUNE - 10 JULY 1998

The course, now in its eleventh year, is intended for epidemiologists, public health practitioners and clinicians with an interest in epidemiology. It offers two main sections on epidemiological methods and issues and on statistical methods (organized in computer-based sessions) and, optionally, three specialized modules plus an innovative module on environment. The course, taught by lecturers mostly from European universities and research institutes, is co-sponsored by the International Agency for Research on Cancer, the Regional Office for Europe of the World Health Organization, the European Union, the Health Authorities of Tuscany, Italy and the International Epidemiological Association.

The residential "Studium" centre is situated in the hills above Florence. The director of the course is Rodolfo Saracci, National Research Council, Pisa, Italy. Sir Richard Doll will be Guest Lecturer.

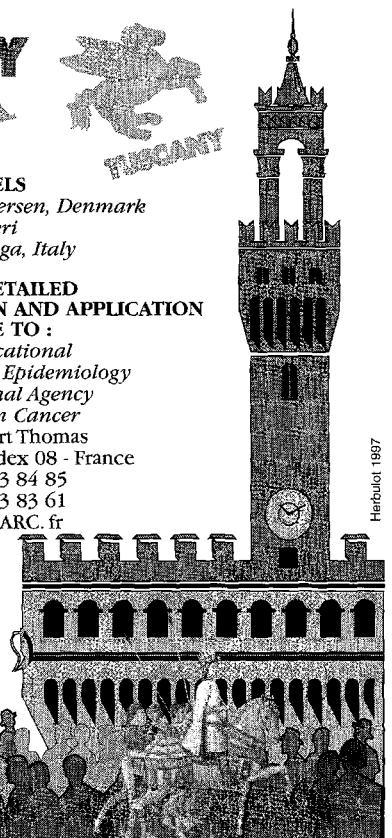
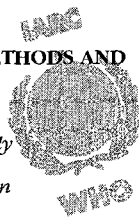
