European Educational Programme in Epidemiology

Annual Residential Summer Course

24 June - 12 July 1991 in Florence, Italy.

The course, now in its fourth year, is intended for epidemiologists, public health practitioners and clinicians with an interest in epidemiology. It is organized by the European Educational Programme in Epidemiology, started in 1988, on the initiative of the Panel for Social Medicine and Epidemiology in the European Community, aiming to foster through educational activities, the development of epidemiology as a fundamental instrument for health promotion in Europe.

The course, which is taught by lecturers from European universities and research institutes, is co-sponsored by the International Agency for Research on Cancer, the Regional Office for Europe of the World Health Organization, the Regional Government of Tuscany and the Commune of Florence in Italy.

The director of the course is Rodolfo Saracci, International Agency for Research on Cancer, Lyon, France, and the venue is the Study Centre, in the hills above Florence.

During the first two weeks, the morning sessions will be devoted to the two major segments of the course, «Epidemiological methods and study design» and «Statistical methods in epidemiology» which will be extended in the third week, with optional modules on «Current issues in epidemiology», and «Statistical regression methods».

In addition, during the second and third weeks, optional afternoon modules will include clinical epidemiology, occupational epidemiology, epidemiology of aids, cardiovascular disease epidemiology, psychiatric epidemiology and genetic epidemiology.
