Behavioral Medicine is an interdisciplinary area of research which seeks to integrate behavioral, psychosocial and biomedical knowledge of relevance for the understanding of health and illness. Resulting principles are applied in prevention, diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of disease.

The congress is organized by the International Society of Behavioral Medicine (ISBM) and hosted by the German Society of Behavioral Medicine and Behavioral Modification.
