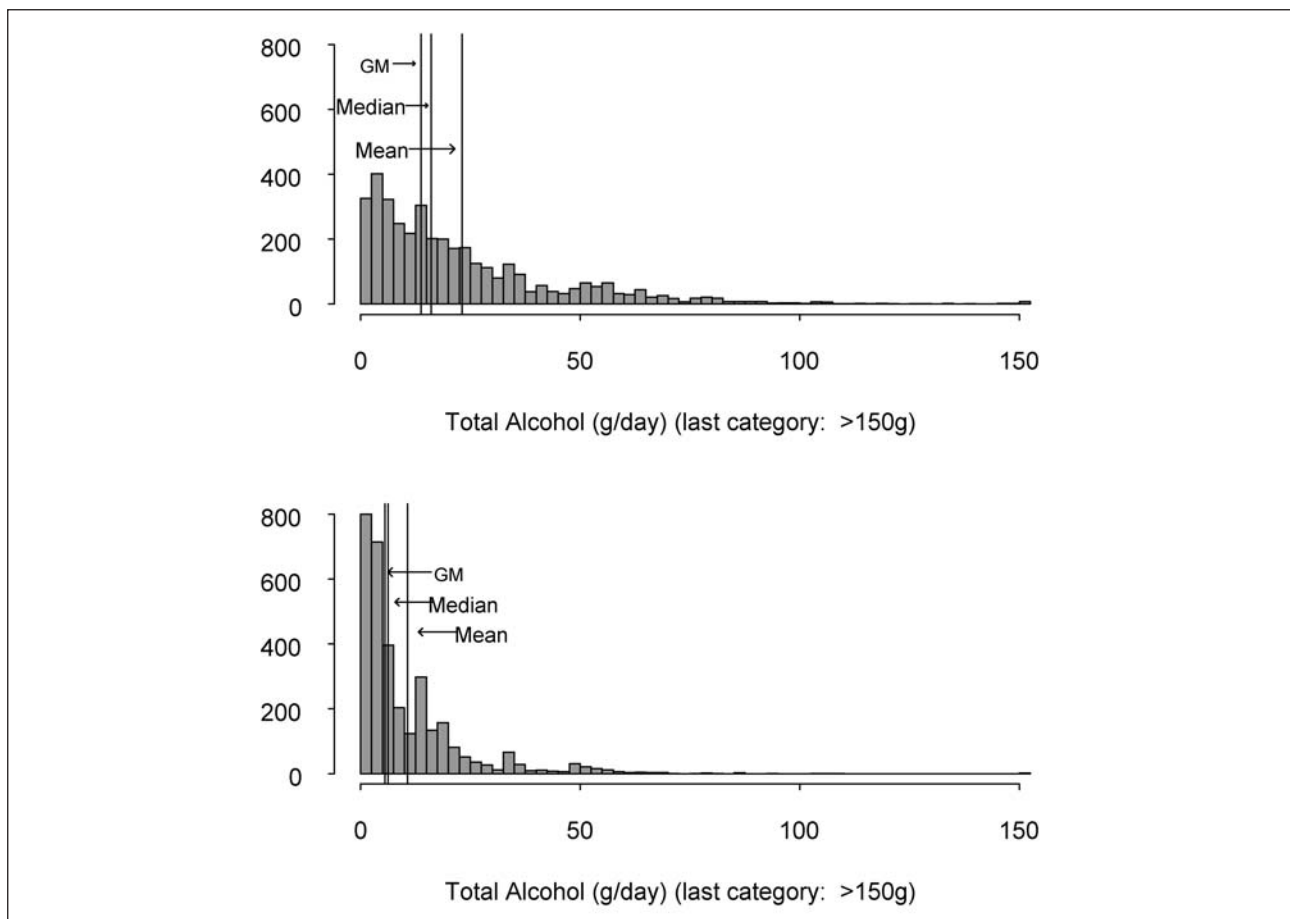


## Erratum: Using percentiles to summarise data instead of means and standard deviations

“The authors point out that although the legend for Figure 1 is correct, Figures 1a (men) and 1b (women) are reversed in the article. In addition, the second sentence in paragraph two on page 427 should begin: “Clearly, men consume much more alcohol (their 95% confidence interval (CI) for the

median is...” (the word “interval” was omitted); and in the right-hand column on page 428, the third sentence in paragraph two should begin: “In practice, the values of L and U are well-approximated (say for  $n \geq 100$ ) by...” (instead of “ $n <= 100$ ”).
