However, there are several major concerns that need to be addressed in a revised version:

- Whenever abbreviations are used in the text for the first time, ensure they are defined. For instance, in the abstract, the initial mention of "JBI guidelines" must be accompanied by its definition.
- In the abstract section. It is best to draw a clearer picture of the study
- Please explain the classification of arid, semi-arid, and dry sub-humid lands in the Review question section, Subsection Context. (I recommend that if several indicators play a role in the classification, summarize them in a table).
- I recommend that in the review question section, you define the auxiliary question related to the costs imposed on governments due to the impact of climate variability, air pollution, and natural disasters on CVD and DM. As a result of this modification, the results, discussion, and conclusion segments also require rectification.
- You can use this recent study (https://doi.org/10.1186/s12992-024-01040-0) to strengthen the discussion
- What are the strengths of your work? Please change the "Study limitation" section to "Strengths and limitations of the study".
- Please add a conclusion section.
